**A**LL the way from the East End streets of London, Hungry and the Hunted will be bringing their own brand of hard hitting rock and punk to Healey's this weekend.

The "all guns blazing outlaw rock 'n' roll" outfit is led by singer-guitarist Azam Khan.

Inspired by Elvis, the Stones, The Clash, Hendrix and Springsteen, Azam started learning his trade by hitting the road in his early 20s with various outfits across the musical spectrum, refining his songwriting craft.

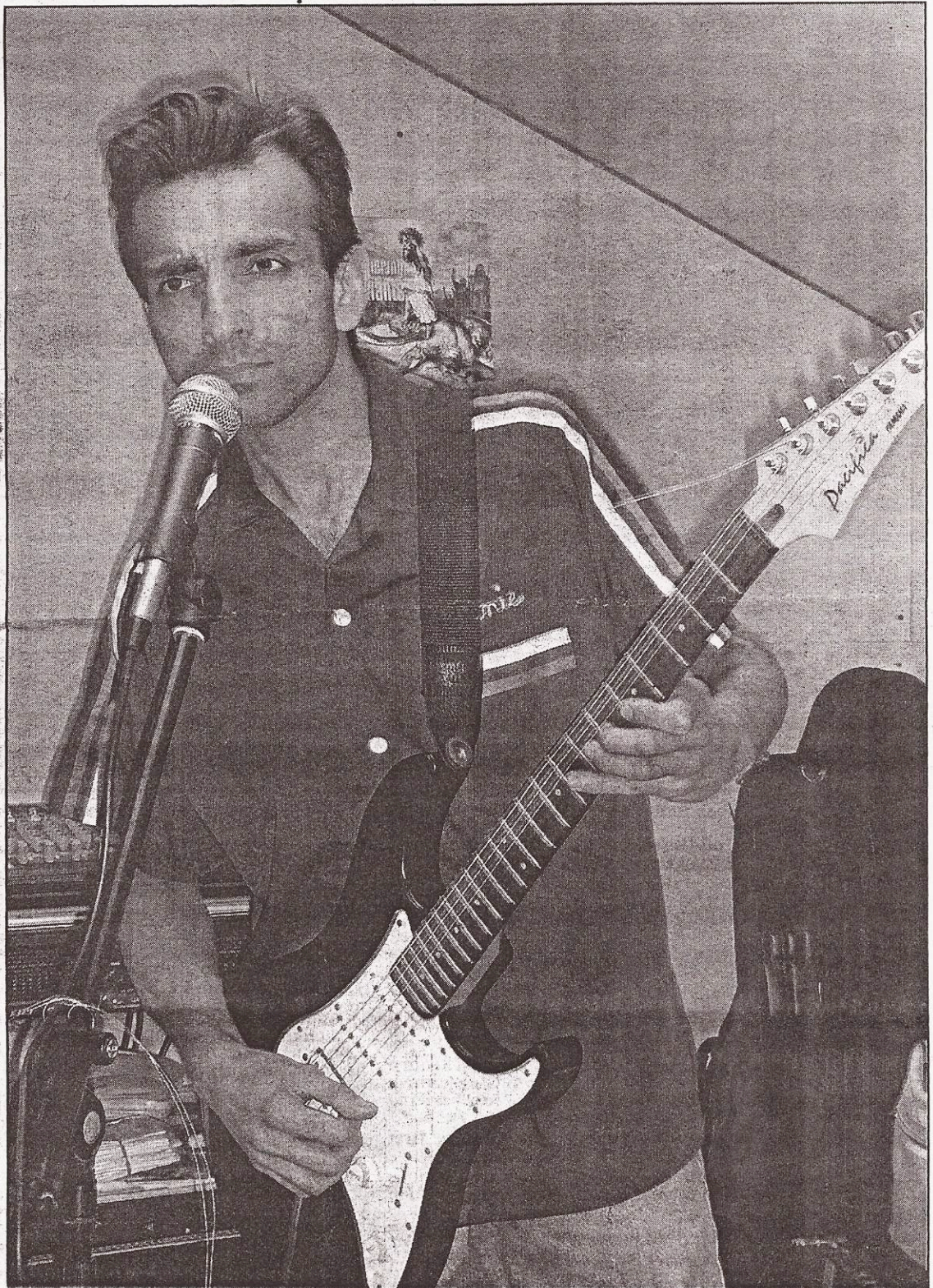
A constant theme running throughout the Hunted song catalogue is a tribute to the spirit of the underdog — "think of it as a soundtrack for the lost, the lonely and the brave souls, who somehow manage to find within themselves the courage to take on the odds regardless of the consequences," says the band's blurb.

Since their inception, the band has been experimenting with line-ups and arrangements, and compiling material.

With Roger Millington (bass) and Sam Leggett (drums) completing the line-up, Hunted are set to release their debut album, *Always on the Run* early next year on Triumphant Sound Records.

The band has already caused quite a stir in the big smoke, with support slots with Dirty Pretty Things and Hard-Fi already under their belts, their jaunt "up north" brings them to Healey's tomorrow night.

The show starts at 9pm, with support coming from local act The Relics, and admission being free
